RE: Annual Notifications for Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
And the Protection of Pupils Rights Amendment

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) has required school districts to add to their annual parent notifications new information on the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA). This information is in addition to the annual requirement that each school district must provide an annual notification of the district's obligations to parents under the PPRA and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g:34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that; protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level. Students to whom the rights have transferred identified in the law as "eligible students."

Attached to this cover letter are three separate documents to notify you of:

1. Annual Notice of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
2. Annual Notice of Release of Director Information Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
3. Annual Notice of the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA)
